Meeting called to order by Tyler Simpson at 7:00 PM

A Special meeting was called to review and discuss the Forest Management Plan Work Orders for the 226 acre Kelly-Drake Conservation Area and the 30 acre Glines Property, submitted by Shaun Lagueux, Forester, New England Forestry Consultants.

Mr. Lagueux outlined the purpose of a Forestry Management Plan and the components of the two plans. The plans will be working documents to assist the Commission in the proper management of these two valuable parcels. Mr. Lagueux will develop the plans over the summer and have the draft of the plan ready for Review at the September meeting of the Commission.

The fee for the Forest Management Plan of the Kelly Drake Conservation Area is \$2,399.80 and the fee for the Glines Property plan is \$1,339.42.

Mr. Leroux made a motion to approve the two plans, seconded by Mr. Pollock and approved unanimously by Commission members.

Mr. Simpson, Chair of the Commission, signed the Management Plan Work Order and will notify Town Supervisor, Barbara Lucas, of the Commission's approval of the plans.

Mr. Pollock brought to the attention of the Commission the request by the Sub-Committee of the Planning Board for Capital Improvements (a capital project or item(s) that results in an estimated net cost of \$10,000 or more with a useful life of 2 years or more). The Commission did not have any requests of the Planning Board for capital improvements.
