Construction Debris Fees

Effective May 25, 2007

The Board of Selectmen held a Public Hearing on May 24, 2007 and amended the fee schedule in the New Hampton Solid Waste Ordinance, adopted on April 1, 1993. The following is the updated fee schedule for the disposal of Construction/Demolition Debris and Bulky Waste items (such as roof shingles, furniture, mattresses, rugs, etc.), Appliances and Tires at the Transfer Station.

TRANSFER STATION HOURS

Monday	8 am – 4 pm
Wednesday	10 am – 4 pm
Saturday	8 am – 4 pm

Construction Debris per Vehicle:

Small trucks, Rangers, S-10's etc., Full-size truck w/short bed, ½ ton short body pickup, utility trailer, & Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV).

FULL LOAD.....\$20.00 HALF.....\$10.00 MIN.....\$5.00

Full size trucks, ½ tons, ¾ ton, w/long bed (8'), 1 ton pickup.

FULL LOAD.....\$30.00 HALF.....\$15.00 MIN.....\$5.00

Stake or Rack or Dump Body

FULL LOAD.....\$60.00 HALF.....\$30.00 MIN.....\$5.00

Others proportional as determined by operator.

Appliances: Refrigerator, Freezer or Air Conditioner \$15.00

Appliances: Others \$ 5.00

Mattresses or Box Springs: (Crib - \$0) \$15.00

Furniture (overstuffed) (sofa) \$15.00 (chair) \$10.00

Rugs & Flooring covering materials: \$10 to \$30.00

Bathroom fixtures including sinks, toilets, etc. \$5.00 to \$10.00

Tires: Bicycle (off rims) N/C

Motorcycles (off rims) \$ 5.00

Under 20" tires \$ 5.00

20" up to 25" \$10.00

Anything over 25" will not be accepted

Propane Tanks (50 lbs or less): \$ 5.00

Shingles: Shingles will be restricted to one 30-gallon trash bag or barrel per day
\$10.00 for a 30 gallon trash bag or barrel.

A minimum charge for C & D shall be \$5.00.
