The Selectmen are looking for residents that may be
interest in serving on a Veteran's Memorial Park
Committee.**

This will be a 5 member committee appointed by the Board of Selectmen. The New Hampton Veteran's Memorial Park Committee's mission is to develop a plan, to include written recommendations for the design, building, funding and maintaining of a memorial park to honor all the men and women in New Hampton and throughout our nation that have honorably served, are serving and will serve in the armed forces of the United States of America. This includes any period of service in the Armed Forces in which the individual is currently serving or has been honorably separated from active or inactive service. This memorial will also commemorate those Veterans that served during any armed conflicts or wars beginning after the Vietnam Conflict.

This Memorial Park will be located at the New Hampton Public Safety Building property in a designated area near the entrance of Intervale Drive. This memorial will be the fourth Memorial erected in New Hampton; The Civil War monument and the World War I monument are located on the Village Common, the World War II monument is located at the Old 1798 Town House and the Korean War & Vietnam Conflict monument and park (recently upgraded by the New Hampton Garden Club and rededicated) are located on the Pemigewasset River off NH Route 104. A written plan and recommendations from the Committee would be submitted to the Board of Selectmen by October 15, 2012.

Boat Registrations in New Hampton

2012 boat registrations can now be processed at the Town Clerk's Office. You do not have to be a New Hampton resident to process your boat registrations. If processed through the State of New Hampshire, the State receives all the revenue, whereas, if processed in New Hampton, New Hampton receives a portion of that revenue to offset taxes.

You must bring in your prior boat registration or renewal that was received by mail.
